GENERAL RULES

Closing Date for Entries: Sunday, October 6, 2019

GENERAL AMATEUR RULES

- All amateur competitors must have a current DSAB, CDS or WDSF affiliate membership.
- Juvenile couples are allowed to compete in the Junior I and Junior II events except at championship level.
- Youth couples are allowed to compete in Adult events. In all age groups one partner of a couple can belong to a younger age-group, except in the Senior I, Senior II, Senior III and Senior IV age groups.
- All competitors must be ready 1 hour before their event and present themselves for costume check. In case of tardiness, the competition will not be delayed.
- In the student/student competition only the lower-level student is being judged. The higher-level student has to have danced at least one level higher than the lower level student in past competitions. If you are an amateur teacher, you must use the student/student entry form.
- All competitors require admission tickets, and to have paid their registration fees.

DRESS CODE

- Amateur/amateur non-championship & student/student events: Dress Code is according to DSAB schedule G. See www.dancesportalbarta.org
- Amateur Championships: Competition dress is obligatory. See www.dancesport.ca

Standard

Men: Black or dark blue tails, white shirt and white tie.

Ladies: Competition Dress.

Latin

Men: Latin costume with sleeves.

PAYMENT, LATE ENTRY and REFUND POLICY

- Early bird price deadline: September 15, 2019
- Registration deadline and fee payment is Sunday, October 6, 2019. Any registrations after this date are at the discretion of the organizers.
- Registrations without payment of entry fees are not considered valid and will not be entered.
- Payment details are provided on the Summary Sheet.
- The organizer has the right to cancel any event. Cancelled events will be refunded.
- There are no refunds on entry fees or tickets purchased
- Entries and payment **must be received by the registrar** by dates quoted to receive early bird prices or to avoid late fees. **Entries and payment given or sent to anyone other than the registrar are not considered received.**

WAIVER & LIABILITY

All amateurs (and, if under age 18, their parents or legal guardians) **must** sign the release on **all** individual entry forms submitted to be eligible to compete.

AGE CLASSIFICATION

The following age classifications are based upon the individual's birthday which occurs within the calendar year

- **Juvenile I:** 9th birthday or less.
- **Juvenile II:** 10th or 11th birthday
- **Junior I:** 12th or 13th birthday
- **Junior II:** 14th or 15th birthday
- **Youth:** 16th, 17th or 18th birthday
- **Under 21:** 16th, 17th, 18th, 19th or 20th birthday
- **Adult:** 19th birthday or more
- **Senior I:** One partner must have reached his or her 35th birthday and the other partner must have reached his or her 30th birthday
- **Senior II:** One partner must have reached his or her 45th birthday and the other partner must have reached his or her 40th birthday.
- **Senior III:** One partner must have reached his or her 55th birthday and the other partner must have reached his or her 50th birthday
- **Senior IV:** One partner must have reached his or her 65th birthday or more. The other partner must have reached her or his 60th birthday or more
